

Terms of Use

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Acceptance of Terms

By accessing or using MyGlassClass.com (the "Site"), the online learning platform operated by the National Glass Association ("NGA," "we," "us," or "our") by creating an account, enrolling in a course, or otherwise using any of our online learning services, you ("you" or "User") agree to be bound by these Terms of Use ("Terms"). If you do not agree to these Terms, please do not use the Site.

If you are accessing the Site on behalf of an organization or as part of an NGA membership benefit, you represent that you have the authority to bind that organization to these Terms.

Description of Service
